Let's talk routines! Why are they important?

Familiar activities can provide comfort for both adults and children during difficult and uncertain times. Just like adults, children feel more secure & confident when their day is predictable and expected. Children feel pride and satisfaction when they are able to complete a task in their routine. Schedules and routines assist children to demonstrate emerging independence & adjust to change more easily.

If your child is experiencing difficulty with routines and transitions, there are ways to help! This can be done through visuals, schedules, and priming! Here are some examples:
