- Maximum grade of 78 per school

- Staff Training
- Student Curriculum and Instruction
- Proper Staffing
- Reporting/Investigation Procedures

Areas of Focus and Recommendations

- Continued training for members of the school safety and climate teams →
 - A member of each school's team will attend a training & turn-keying the info back to the other team members
- Increase training for Anti-Bullying Specialists on Cyberbullying. →
 - ABS will attend training on developments in state & federal law, including case law, emerging trends, & cyberbullying, & guidance from the NJDOE & USDOE by Legal One.
- Further implementation of programs to focus on social and emotional learning →
 - Continuing "Structured Play Initiative"; Safety Patrol; Piner Patrol, Rethink SEL, Kindness Challenge, Week of Respect

Student Safety Data System (SSDS)

- Replaces the Electronic Violence and Vandalism Reporting System (EVVRS)
- Replaces the Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying-Investigations, Trainings and Programs (HIB-ITP)
- Does not replace HIB self-assessment
- What is Collected?
- Incidents occurring on school grounds
 - Violence – Vandalism – Weapons offenses – Substance offenses.
- Incidents occurring on and off school grounds
 - Harassment, intimidation, or bullying (HIB) – Other incidents leading to removal
- HIB trainings
- HIB programs
