# What Makes Lakewood Unique?

- Lakewood has a population of **100,000 +**
- Lakewood is the fastest growing municipality, and the 4<sup>th</sup> largest in the State.
- Lakewood Public Schools – 88% Hispanic, 7% African American, 4% White, 1% Other.
- Lakewood Public Schools – 100% Free Breakfast & Lunch
- 1,883 English Language Learners (ELL)
- One of the only Districts in N.J. to serve students with in-person services during the Health-Related School Closure.

# COVID -19 & Antibody Testing

## (The Lakewood School District & Beyond)

- August of 2020 – OHI & Chemed – Conducted Nasal/PCR Testing at all of the District’s Summer Programs.
- Last week of August 2020 – Medlabs conducted Nasal/PCR & Antibody Testing at LHS for all students and staff of the District prior to the opening of School, September 1, 2020.
- COVID-19 Saliva Testing at LHS – October 7 through October 10, 2020
- COVID-19 Saliva Testing at LHS – October 14<sup>th</sup> & October 15, 2020
- COVID-19 Saliva Testing at LHS – October 21<sup>st</sup> & October 22, 2020
- COVID-19 Saliva Testing at Oak Street School – November 2, 2020

# COVID -19 Testing Lakewood Township

- **Since the end of September:**

- The NJDOH has deployed **33 Testing sites** across Lakewood.
- Chemed has performed over **33,634** total tests.
- According to Judith Persichilli, Commissioner of Health, Lakewood's percent positivity went from a high of 36% in late September to 5.64% (Shore News Network)

# Flu Vaccines

- The Lakewood School District has partnered with Chemed Health and Ocean Health Initiatives (OHI) in order to ensure that all students and staff of the Lakewood School District are protected against the Flu.
- During the week of October 26, 2020, approximately 1,000+ students and staff members were given the flu vaccine during school hours.
- Getting a flu vaccine is especially important this season because the flu and the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) cause similar common signs and symptoms. Flu vaccination could reduce symptoms that might be confused with those caused by COVID-19. Preventing the flu and reducing the severity of flu illness and hospitalizations could also lessen the stress on the health care system (Mayo Clinic).

## STUDENT BREAKFAST & LUNCH
