- Ratings for each indicator based on specific criteria and documentation
- Maximum grade of 78 per school

The self-assessment tool and rubric were used to evaluate each school's performance in areas such as:

- ❑ Programs to Prevent Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying
- ❑ Staff Training
- ❑ Student Curriculum and Instruction
- ❑ Proper Staffing
- ❑ Reporting/Investigation Procedures

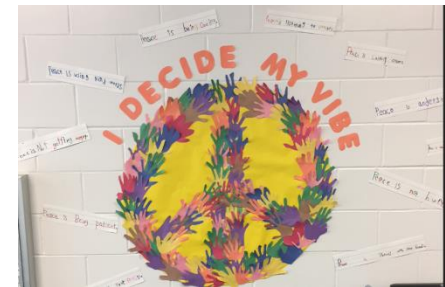
