Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- **Gloves:**

- Staff Members may request via their building Administrator, as needed

- **Facemasks:**

- All Students and staff members were provided with cloth face masks.
- All students and staff members may request cloth face masks, as needed.
- All students and staff members may request disposable face masks, as needed.
- Disposable face masks are also provided to the Bus Vendors, for any student who may attempt to get on a bus without a face mask.

- **Face Shields:**

- All students and staff members were provided with a face shield.
- All students and staff may request additional face shields as needed.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- **Hand Sanitizer:** (Piranha with 70%Alcohol)
 - Every classroom and Office in the District has a bottle of Hand Sanitizer.
 - Custodians fill the Hand Sanitizer's at the request of the teacher/staff members.
 - Hand Sanitizer stations are placed in hallways in every building.
- **Plexiglass-Polycarbonate:**
 - (Desks, Offices, Lunch Tables, Nurses station, Restrooms)
 - Every students' desk, across the district has plexiglass-ploycarbonate.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- **Hand held Thermometers:**

- Bus Monitors are used on every bus to take the temperatures of every student, prior to the students entering the bus. Should the student have a temperature, he/she is not allowed entry onto the bus. The bus driver alerts dispatch about a student having a temperature, dispatch alerts the Principal, who calls home to make sure the student arrived home safely.
- If the Monitor is absent from the bus, and a substitute was not on the bus, the bus company alerts the school, who has staff members waiting for the bus. The staff members take the students off the bus, and take their temperatures, prior the their entry into the school building.

- **Temperature Kiosk:**

- Temperature Kiosks are found at the entrance of each school, and are utilized by all staff members and visitors.

Cleaning

- **Electrostatic Guns:** (12 disinfectant applicators)
- **Bioesque Disinfectant botanical:** (45 gallons)
- **Flex wipes:** (Electronic device wipes)
- **Additional Aramark COVID-19 Cleaning Staff:** \$321,000 (Additional staff for COVID cleaning)
- **Cleaning Supplies** - Bioesque, flexwipes, 364H, Bru-tabs
- **Lunch Wipes** - Sodexo provides lunch wipes

Air Control and Quality

Temporary Classroom

- Mobile lease: \$2,030,000 (Additional structures for social distance)
 - 16 New Classrooms at Lakewood Middle School



Every Classroom has:

- Polycarbonate desk shields for both students and staff
- G clean hand sanitizer (**70% alcohol**)
- 364H spray bottles along with paper towels
- Flex wipes for electronics
- Sani Cleaning multi surface wipes used after meals

The following safety measures are in place:

- Upgraded Merv Filter for Hvac system
- Throughout the day, common areas and touchpoints are being continuously disinfected and monitored (checklist attached).
- During the evening the rooms are cleaned thoroughly and sanitized using the Electrostatic disinfectant applicator with Bioesque disinfectant.
- Additional PPE is supplied immediately upon request.
- OH Air Purifiers (waiting on arrival of stock and delivery for remainder of district)
 - EGC (Completed)
 - LECC, Campus 1 (Completed)
 - LECC, Campus 2 (Completed)
 - LECC, Campus 3 (Completed)
 - District Office (Completed)
 - Princeton Avenue (Completed)
 - White House (Completed)

Transportation:

- Due to COVID-19, the Lakewood Board of Education decreased the bus load counts to **no more than 41 students**.

Bus Counts as of March 1 2021

Regular Education

- Clifton – Average of 32 students per bus
- Clark – Average of 34 students per bus
- LHS- Average of 33 students per bus
- Oak- Average of 30 students per bus
- Spruce – Average of 34 students per bus
- LMS - Average of 32 students per bus
- Piners- Average of 37 students per bus
- LECC- Average of 20 students per bus

- Clifton – Average of 15 students per bus

Transportation

- All students and bus drivers must wear a face mask at all times.
- Windows must be kept open (weather permitting).
- Bus drivers must sanitize all touch points between each bus route.
- Buses are brought back to the bus depot and cleaned and sanitized at the end of each driver's bus run.
- All students have on the bus have assigned seats, which are placed on a seating chart and given to each School Administrators for the purpose of Contact Tracing.
- The first two seats behind the bus driver are kept vacant for the health and safety of the bus driver.
- The Lakewood School District provides disposable face masks to the bus vendors, in order for students to get to school safely.

Bus Monitors

- **Bus Monitors – Towne Nursing**

- Bus Monitors, are provided by Town Nursing, and are used **on every bus** to take the temperatures of each student, **prior to** the student entering the bus. Should the student have a temperature, he/she is not allowed entry onto the bus. The bus driver alerts dispatch about a student having a temperature, dispatch alerts the Principal, who calls home to make sure the student arrived home safely.
- If the Monitor is absent from the bus, and a substitute was not on the bus, the bus company alerts the school, who has staff members waiting for the bus. The staff members take the students off the bus, and take their temperatures, prior to their entry into the school building.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- In partnership with Chemed Health in Lakewood, approximately 200+ **eligible** staff members (Nurses, Therapists, Security, High-Risk Staff) were given the COVID-19 Vaccine since January (Moderna).
- On Monday, March 15, 2021, approximately 380 staff members voluntarily received the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine in the gymnasium of Lakewood High School.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- On Tuesday, March 16, 2021, approximately 680 of the following were vaccinated in the heated tents, in the parking lot of Lakewood High School.
 - Lakewood Nonpublic School Staff Members
 - Ocean Academy Charter School Staff Members
 - Lakewood Private Schools for the Disabled Staff Members
 - Staff Members of Transportation Vendors who provide services to Lakewood Public and Nonpublic children.
 - Staff Members of approved Vendors who provide educational services to Lakewood Schools; such as, Catapult, TOK, Tender Touch, On Track, etc.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- On Tuesday, March 17, 2021, 800 + vaccines are projected to be given.
