SYNOPSIS

Requires board of education or school bus contractor, within one business day of notification that school bus driver's license is suspended or revoked, to verify to DOE that driver is no longer operating school bus.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. If a board of education or a contractor that provides pupil
8 transportation services under contract with a board of education is
9 notified by the Department of Education that a school bus driver
10 employed by the board or contractor has had his bus driver's license
11 suspended or revoked, the employing board of education or
12 contractor, within ¹**[24 hours]** one business day¹ of the notification,
13 shall provide a statement to the department verifying that the school
14 bus driver no longer operates a school bus for the board or
15 contractor.

17 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
