STATEMENT BY BOARD PRESIDENT

Pursuant to Board Policy 0164, Roberts’ Rules of Order shall govern the Board of Education in its deliberations and in the conduct of its meetings. As such, all comments from the public and from other members of the Board should be directed to the Board President who is responsible for presiding over the meeting.

Anyone who desires to ask a question must email to boemeeting@lakewoodpiners.org, between 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. the evening of the meeting, and provide their proper name, full address and the question.

The President shall direct all inquiries or comments to the appropriate Administrator or Board member for response, as appropriate. The law requires a period of public comment at our meetings, not a question or answer session or debate. The board president at his discretion may or may not feel it is appropriate to answer questions raised during the public comment period. The board and administration do take all public comments seriously and consider them when conducting business.

The President may interrupt, warn, or terminate a participant’s statement when the statement is too lengthy, abusive or obscene. In addition, Security Personnel may direct any individual to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum, whether the person is at the microphone or at any other place in the meeting room. New Jersey law makes it a crime for any person to intentionally disrupt a public meeting. Law enforcement will be contacted if a person disrupts the meeting and fails to desist after being directed to do so.

Finally, we ask that you silence all electronic devices.

Approve the Addendum No 1 Agreement for Title I, Title IIA and Title III Professional Development to enrich Teacher Knowledge in Providing Instruction for At Risk children in Private Schools and Title I Parental Involvement for Parents of Title I Nonpublic Students in Lakewood with **Catapult Learning, LLC** to include the utilization of CARES Act funds for July 1, 2020 thru August 31, 2020.
- E. Approve **Tender Touch Educational Services, LLC** to continue to provide IDEA NPSSP and Extension Program and ICRP Services from July 1, 2020 thru August 31, 2020 in order to render payment for Administrators, Supervisors and Secretaries to continue services as well as purchase supplies and material for upcoming school year provided the purchases are approved by the school district in advance of purchase. Cost is not to exceed \$76,000 for NPSSP Services \$45,000 for Extension Program and \$80,000 for ICRP Services. Cost of services shall not exceed 3% which represents current CPI Index rate. CARES funds can also be utilized for this program.
- F. Approve the Assistant Business Administrator and Purchasing Agent to advertise a Competitive Contract for IDEA Nonpublic Supplemental Services, Extension Program and In Class Resource Program Services for the 2020/2021.
- G. Approve rescinding the approval of item #88 from the June 24, 2020 Board of Education meeting. In its place approve **Torah Umesorah** for Mentoring Services including Counseling, Social Skills and Transitional Skills at a cost OF \$60.00 per hour not to exceed \$44,000 effective July 1, 2020. Funding will be provided by CARES Act and any and all applicable Federal and State grants. All staff must have criminal history background check. The Board must be appropriately indemnified and must be named as an additional insured to the

satisfaction of the Board before instruction can commence in the following amounts:

Contractor shall maintain or cause to be maintained, in full force and effect, insurance in such amounts and against such risks as follows:

- i. Broad form, comprehensive, or commercial General Liability Insurance coverage, including contractual liability, against claims for personal injury, death or property damage in an amount of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) with respect to injury or death of a single person and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in the aggregate, and One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) with respect to property damage, together with Excess/Umbrella Liability Insurance in an amount of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), Fire Damage Insurance in an amount of not less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) and Medical Expense Insurance in an amount of not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00); and
- ii. Workers Compensation Insurance coverage in the minimum amount required by the specifications for the Services as follows: Employer's Liability Insurance coverage in an amount not less than One Million Thousand Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for bodily injury caused by accident or disease and One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence for automobile liability or in the statutory amount, whichever is greater; and
- iii. Professional Liability Insurance coverage in an amount of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) with respect to a single claim and Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in the aggregate, which the Contractor shall maintain for no less than six (6) years following completion of Services.

H. Approve the Assistant Business Administrator and Purchasing Agent to advertise a Competitive Contract for Mentoring Services, including Counseling, Social Skills and Transitional Skills for the 2020/2021 school year using CARES Act Funding and all other applicable grant funding.
