STATEMENT BY BOARD PRESIDENT

Pursuant to Board Policy 0164, Roberts’ Rules of Order shall govern the Board of Education in its deliberations and in the conduct of its meetings. WHEREAS, The Board of Education of the Township of Lakewood in the County of Ocean, New Jersey is seeking to submit a proposal to the voters of the School District at the annual School District election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 and to authorize certain actions required to be taken in connection with the conduct of the Election and the presentation of the Proposal.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Board of Education of the Township of Lakewood in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (not less than a majority of the full membership of the Board concurring) as follows:
